### Read 1 Corinthians 8

1. “Love builds up” (1 Cor. 8:1b). What are some practical ways you can encourage family and friends during the COVID-19 season?
2. The issue in this passage is eating meat offered to idols. What are some things today that could cause a believer to stumble? What is our responsibility in these areas?
3. In our time of social distancing, digital communication is an important means of connection...and sharing the Gospel. Discuss ways in which you can share the Gospel effectively using digital means.
4. Paul writes, “take care that this right of yours does not somehow become a stumbling block to the weak” (1 Cor. 8:9). It seems possible that someone could be offended by anything we do, in effect, robbing us of all Christian freedom. Are we to give up all Christian freedom, if need be? How can we balance Christian freedom and offending others with that freedom?
5. Read 1 Cor. 8:13. Share a time when you have sacrificed something in order to keep a weaker Christian from stumbling.
