

Discussion Questions

April 26 – May 2

Read 1 Corinthians 15:50-58

1. This past weekend, the word we focused on was VICTORY. Read together 1 Corinthians 15:54-57. What comes to mind when you read those verses describing how - through Jesus - we experience eternal victory?
2. We shared that one way we can demonstrate our eternal victory through Jesus now is through the “bond of Christian Community.” How have you experienced the blessings of Christian Community? How do relationships between believers differ from relationships between believers and unbelievers?
3. We discussed the importance in our culture of relativism and individualism, and the need for us to remain steadfast to the absolute truth of God’s Word. Where do people search for truth today outside of God’s Word? Read Colossians 1:23 and discuss some practical ways for a believer to remain steadfast in their commitment to the truth of God’s Word.
4. Read Psalm 112:6-8 and 1 Corinthians 15:58. We discussed that with Eternal Victory already secured, even in life’s toughest battles, we can have unwavering trust in our immovable God. Share a time when you were going through a trial and how - through trust in God - He used that time to mold you as a follower of Jesus Christ.
5. Read again 1 Corinthians 15:58. The word abounding literally means – “over and above”. Knowing that Eternal Victory over sin and death is a done deal, this calls us not to be complacent - but urgent - and go “over and above” in our worship and service for the Lord. Everything we do (job, marriage, parenting, school, relationships, stewardship of finances...) is an act of worship and can viewed as work unto the Lord. What’s an area of your life you would like prayer in - right now - for God to help you to see it more as worship unto Him?
