

DEBARY RE-OPENING GUIDELINES

- 1. Seating will be in groups of 2, 3, 4, and 5 seats with a 6-foot distance in between each section of chairs.
- 2. Greeters will be instructed to avoid handshaking. However, we do encourage smiles and waves as they guide people to the worship center.
- 3. Please do not congregate in the lobby. Once you enter the building through the main doors, go straight to the sanctuary and find a seat suitable for your family's size (i.e. 2, 3, 4, or 5 seats).
- 4. Certain areas will be blocked to prevent crowding in tight spaces.
- 5. There will be no café or coffee available; however, you are welcomed to bring your own coffee and snacks. We will re-examine this on a weekly basis.
- 6. Parents are encouraged to keep their children with them at all times until the Children's Ministry resumes. Please escort your children (elementary age and younger) throughout the facility, including the restrooms.
- 7. The Ushers will monitor the restrooms from the lobby to make sure there is no crowding taking place and to encourage people to wait.
- 8. Two services will ONLY occur if there are enough people registered to attend. This will help limit the number of people per service to approximately half of our normal Sunday attendance and allow room for guests. We will clean the sanctuary and bathrooms with disinfectant in between services.
- 9. The sanctuary doors, as well as doors leading outside, will be kept open to avoid contact points.
- 10. Worship will be paperless, so we encourage you to bring a journal or notebook to take notes. We will guide guests to fill out connect cards online or by text.
- 11. We will attempt to have plenty of soap, paper towels, and hand sanitizer avaiable to use.
- 12. We will clean and disinfect equipment including: tech, worship, and etc.
- 13. We will have an organized dismissal of the sanctuary by section. The main and side doors will be utilized to avoid crowding.
- 14. There will be no communion for the month of May, and we will re-examine this process on a monthly basis. Once we feel that we can distribute the elements and collect the cups safely, communion will resume.
- 15. We highly encourage all attenders to wear masks, however, we ask that you do not wear gloves due to the possibility of Latex contact allergies.
- 16. We know that it has been awhile since you've seen each other, and you may want to chat, fellowship, and greet one another. However, we ask that you do so in the parking lot with proper social distancing.

Please understand, I know that not everyone is in the same place and will not be ready to come back right away. I RESPECT your decision 110%! Regardless of when you chose to join us, we will have a chair waiting for you! Until then, feel free to watch the South Hills livestream, or you can watch the Debary livestream as well if the message is local. We love you, we respect you, and we cannot wait until that day when we are all together again.

In order to properly prepare for in-person worship, I am asking you to do something VERY IMPORTANT! Please fill out the registration form on our page at www.tbcdebary.org to register for the worship service by Friday of each week. We are trying to account for how many people will be present on Sunday in case we need to add a second service. This will give us time to contact everyone who registered to ensure we can adhere to proper social distancing.
