This past weekend we used the acronym SSAFE to discuss our Spiritual Identity in Jesus Christ: *Significant, Secure, Accepted, Forgiven, Empowered*

Let's walk through those areas in our discussion this week:

1. **SIGNIFICANT:** In lieu of Jesus, where do people turn to today in search for significance in this life? Is there an area in your life right now where you still find yourself at times struggling when it comes to your self-worth? How does one find their significance in Jesus?
2. **SECURE:** When it comes to eternal security, a believer has assurance they belong to God and nothing can ever change that. Read Romans 8:31-39. How should our eternal security impact our daily walk with the Lord?
3. **ACCEPTED:** Read Romans 8:14-17. As believers in Jesus Christ, we are truly God's children...and our adoption is so intimate Paul says we cry, "Abba, Father." The Aramaic word "Abba," which means "Dear Father" or we might say today "Dad" or "Daddy". What goes through your mind knowing that we can have such an intimate relationship with our "Abba, Father"?
4. **FORGIVEN:** Read Romans 8:1. No condemnation means I am forgiven. My past doesn't hang over my head, and my future sins have been paid for in full by Jesus. How should this truth impact how we interact as brothers and sisters in Christ? How does it impact how we forgive one another?
5. **EMPOWERED:** Read Romans 8:9-11. The moment a person trusts in Jesus, they have the full indwelling of the Holy Spirit living within them and He gives them all they need to live for God. What are some ways the Holy Spirit empowers us to live for God? Read Romans 8:26-27. What goes through your mind when you hear those verses?
