

# Discussion Questions

1. Read the following verses: Psalm 147:5, Romans 11:33 and Psalm 145:3. When we say that incomprehensibility is an attribute of God, what does it mean and how should it shape our approach to understanding God?

2. Read Psalm 19:1-2 and Romans 1:20.

Our first point this weekend was:

***God clearly reveals himself through his CREATION.***

Our response:

***Be intentional in noticing and connecting with God through his Creation.***

How has God revealed himself through his physical Creation alone? What are some ways someone can experience God in his Creation?

3. Read 1 Peter 1:20-21 and 2 Timothy 3:16.

Our second point this weekend was:

***God clearly reveals himself through his WORD.***

Our response:

***Commit to reading God's Word daily and connecting to Biblical community.***

Why is it important for personal devotion in God's Word and not just relying on a Pastor or other person? What is God currently teaching you – or what has He recently taught you – through His Word that has impacted your life?

4. Read Romans 5:8 and John 14:6.

Our third point this weekend was:

***God clearly reveals himself through his SON - JESUS CHRIST.***

Our response:

***Trust in Jesus, follow Jesus, and share Jesus.***

If willing, share with the group when you trusted in Jesus as your Lord and Savior. What's an area you need to focus on this week in order to continue to keep Jesus Christ at the center of your daily life?



5. Dave mentioned another way God reveals himself is through His Church. Read Romans 10:13-15. Who is someone you want to pray for this week – that they would come to a saving faith in Jesus and trust in Him alone as their Lord and Savior? Pray for those individuals as you close, and that God would use you to reveal Christ to them.
