- 1) When we hear the word “wrath” – we immediately think of human wrath or anger. Read **Psalm 78:58** and **Romans 1:18** and discuss how God’s wrath differs from human wrath.
- 2) How can God have the attributes of both wrath and love?
- 3) Why is it important that we preach about the holy and just wrath of God **AND** the love of God – not just one or the other?
- 4) In the sermon this past weekend, we discussed the following questions: “why His wrath,” “how does He carry out His wrath,” and “upon whom does He carry out His wrath”:

WHY: God is **holy**; therefore, He is pure and separate from all evil and sin

HOW: God is **just**; therefore, He judges all impartially according to His righteous standard

WHO: God is **love**; therefore, He placed our deserved punishment for sin on His Son, Jesus Christ

It’s our hope for believers that an understanding of God’s wrath would cause you to revere Him and follow hard after Jesus. What is your biggest takeaway from the sermon/scriptures we discussed this past weekend?

- 5) If God doesn’t give you that career, relationship, or “fill in the blank” desire...is Jesus Christ and your salvation in Him enough for you? If so, how can you proclaim with your life that **HE IS WORTHY** and **HE IS ENOUGH** for you? What is one action step you feel led to take based on the message and our discussion? How can the group support you in taking this step?
