- 1) Read James 3:16. Why is jealousy viewed as such a negative word in our culture? What are sinful ways we as human beings exude jealousy?
- 2) Read Exodus 20:3-5, Exodus 34:14, Colossians 1:16. How is God's jealousy pure and holy? In what ways does He exude his jealousy?
- 3) The late theologian Abraham Kypur once said: *"There is not a square inch in the whole domain of our human existence over which Christ, who is Sovereign over all, does not cry, Mine!"* What goes through your mind when you hear that quote?
- 4) Read 2 Corinthians 11:2-3. The idol of "self" began with the fall of man with Adam and Eve in the garden. If willing to be vulnerable with your group for a moment...share what idols you sometimes battle that take your devotion away from the Lord.
- 5) We ended this weekend with this statement: **"GOD IS JEALOUS FOR US...WE ARE ZEALOUS FOR HIM!"** Practically, how can believers in Jesus Christ be zealous for God? What can you do this week to display your zeal for the Lord?
