- 3. When God called Moses to a big assignment, Moses offered several excuses as to why he was not the person for the job. I have listed his excuses below. Can you relate to these excuses? Which one/s?
  - I am not worthy (Ex. 3:12)
  - I don't think I have the authority (Ex. 3:13-14)
  - What will people say? (Ex 4:1)
  - I don't have what it takes (Ex. 4:10)
  - I don't want the assignment (Ex. 4:13)

God answered each excuse with His Person. He is more than capable of delivering us from whatever is holding us down or holding us back.
