1. Share one or two personal highlights from this past week.
2. As you interact with people in your network of family and friends, what are some of the biggest challenges you've noticed people are feeling and facing?
3. When God called Moses to a big assignment, Moses offered several excuses as to why he was not the person for the job. I have listed his excuses below. Can you relate to these excuses? Which one/s?
 - I am not worthy (Ex. 3:12)
 - I don't think I have the authority (Ex. 3:13-14)
 - What will people say? (Ex 4:1)
 - I don't have what it takes (Ex. 4:10)
 - I don't want the assignment (Ex. 4:13)

God answered each excuse with His Person. He is more than capable of delivering us from whatever is holding us down or holding us back.

4. In Exodus 14, the people of Israel were between a rock and a hard place—the Egyptian army and the Red Sea. Read Exodus 14:13-14. Describe a time when you experienced God fighting for you.
5. Read Romans 8:31-32. Based on this passage, why can we be confident that God will always fight for us?
