- To be equipped with a biblical understanding of the issues that surround marriage and families.
- To personally apply the biblical truths.

FIVE THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT PARENTING:

1. Children are gift from God.

Psalm 127:3

Behold, children are a gift of the Lord, The fruit of the womb is a reward.

- 2. Parents have to have their spiritual act together.
- 3. The best thing you can do for your child is to be committed to their mother/father.
- 4. Be the parent!
- 5. Parenting is modeling and mentoring.

Three things to start doing today:

1. Carve out time and guard the time for couple and family devotions.

But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have become convinced of, because you know those from whom you learned it, and how from infancy you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus.
