

Pastor/Director of Next Generation

The Pastor/Director of Next Generation has a driving passion to reach the next generation of children, students, young adults, parents and recruit the volunteers to accomplish that mission.

Next Generation Staff Oversight Responsibilities:

- Align Children and Student Ministry Leaders
 - Lead, develop, and shepherd the next generation staff including Pastors/Directors of Chapel Kids, Special Needs, Sports, Preschool) and Students (56, Junior High, and Senior High)
 - Ensure the most effective and efficient strategies are employed to reach children, students, volunteers and parents
- **Drive** the message
 - Ensure that Biblical truth is communicated through engaging, relevant and memorable experiences in all next generation ministries
 - Coach Ministry Leaders in teaching methods and best practices
 - Oversee and guide curriculum selection
 - Develop and implement scope and sequence that adequately transitions each phase of next generation ministry into the next (i.e. 56 to Jr.High)
- Elevate Team TBC Recruitment
 - Coach next generation staff on how to recruit, train and develop their volunteer leaders under the Team TBC model
 - Ensure all volunteer onboarding procedures and training is consistent
- Engage Parents
 - Engage and resource every parent to have a positive influence in the spiritual development of their own kids
 - Ensure consistent communication with parents
 - Train staff to partner with parents
- Create Community
 - Ensure that next generation ministry leaders are creating an environment where every child and student is connected and cared for
- Influence Service

- Coach next generation staff to create consistent opportunities for students to serve
- This includes serving in the regular weekly ministries and worship services as well as missional work locally and globally

Young Adult Responsibilities:

- Cast Vision for a highly engaging Young Adults Ministry
- Engage College students and Young adults through groups model, serving and social gatherings
- Create Community where every college student and young adult is connected and cared for.
- **Influence Service** by creating consistent opportunities for college students and young adults to serve.
 - Create opportunities for service as a volunteer in regular weekly ministries and worship services,
- Recruit, develop, and shepherd a team of volunteers and core leaders to lead the YA ministries
